The Power and Principles of A True Apostolic Community

Acts 2:41-47

- 41 "Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.
- 42 And they continued stedfastly (Firm, Loyal and Unwavering) in the apostles doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.
- 43 And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.
- 44 And all that believed were together, and had all things common;
- 45 And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all men, as every man had need.
- 46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,
- 47 Praising God, and having favour (free generosity and mercy) with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved."

Introduction: To understand and to consider with serious engaging, the assignment of becoming a replica of the early Church as an apostolic movement and community, we must look at it at its birth, so that we can see it at its best.

Analyzing without Alignment and Allegiance to its head, will never give way to the fruit of Assimilation. We can't copy and paste it's power unless we are ready to covet and taste its process and persecution. I. A Commitment To Developing An Apostolic Educational System v.42a

They continued in the apostle's doctrine...

II. A Commitment To Fostering Community Through Ongoing Fellowship v.42b

They devoted themselves to fellowship, the breaking of bread, and prayer.

III. They Created and Cultivated An Atmosphere Where the Miraculous and the Supernatural Was The Norm v.43

Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles.

IV. They Created A Sustainable Economic Ecosystem v. 44-45 All the believers were together and had everything in

common. They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need.

V. They Were Committed To Consistent In Person Corporate Congregational Gathering (Church Attendance) v.46a

Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts

VI. Their Authenticity and Sincerity In Living Out Their Beliefs and Convictions Was Attractive v. 46b-47a

They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people.

VII. Their Commitment To Fostering A Spiritual Community Had Undeniable Social Impact Evidenced By Church Growth (Evangelism)v.47b

And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved
