Genesis 12:9-20 KJV

9 “And Abram journeyed, going on still toward the south.

10 And there was a famine in the land: and Abram went down into Egypt to sojourn there; for the famine was grievous in the land.

11 And it came to pass, when he was come near to enter into Egypt, that he said unto Sarai his wife, Behold now, I know that thou art a fair woman to look upon:

12 therefore it shall come to pass, when the Egyptians shall see thee, that they shall say, This is his wife: and they will kill me, but they will save thee alive.

13 Say, I pray thee, thou art my sister: that it may be well with me for thy sake; and my soul shall live because of thee.

14 And it came to pass, that, when Abram was come into Egypt, the Egyptians beheld the woman that she was very fair.

15 The princes also of Pharaoh saw her, and commended her before Pharaoh: and the woman was taken into Pharaoh's house.

16 And he entreated Abram well for her sake: and he had sheep, and oxen, and he asses, and menservants, and maidservants, and she asses, and camels.

17 And the LORD plagued Pharaoh and his house with great plagues because of Sarai Abram's wife.

18 And Pharaoh called Abram, and said, What is this that thou hast done unto me? why didst thou not tell me that she was thy wife?

19 Why saidst thou, She is my sister? so I might have taken her to me to wife: now therefore behold thy wife, take her, and go thy way.

20 And Pharaoh commanded his men concerning him: and they sent him away, and his wife, and all that he had.”

Abrahamic Summary: Lies and Lot, Abram’s Nephew.

God leads by his paternal instincts. He’s bringing you to a place where you not only see him as creator but as Father; and that takes him transforming your mind, which includes how you receive and understand fatherhood. This is the relational side of God where we become personal and intimate with each other. As in The case of Abram and Sarai, God transformed their nature and changed their names to Abraham (Father of a multitude of Nations) and Sarah (Mother of Nations). God wants to make you into something that’s bigger than just yourself.

Introduction: The Process Summary: The necessity of repetitive thought, practice and action, is essential to the advancement of knowledge and understanding. Experience is the result of personal encounters that shape into proper form, your behavior and maturity. You cannot expect to grow just through theoretical knowledge; application is the recipe that validates **what you read in theory, you confirm through personal application.** You can definitely gain knowledge through reading, but to be sure of what you know, you have to walk it out in order to work it out.

So let the record reflect that the Holy Spirit of God did not and does not bring us into assemblies like this for personal optics, but for spiritual development. We don't do this to impress, we do this to improve our character by disciplining our behavioral patterns, and improving our idiosyncratic tendencies and proclivities. You do know that we born into sin. **Psalms 51: 5 - Behold I was shaped and formed in iniquity; And in Sin did my mother conceive me.**

Iniquity: Behavior that is totally contrary to what is morally right or correct. They are inherent and generational traits that make us human, and in need of a divine encounter with God.

The Strategy of Process:

1. Divine Direction: God's Plan for Your Process

2. Divine Details: Spiritual insight that gives distinct clarity to your path and process.

3. Designed Difficulties: Hard challenges that come with purpose and process. Nothing with value is easily attained.

4. Development in Delays: Preparing you for what you think you are ready for, but God knows that you are not.

5. Demonic Distractions: Things that impact your attention span.

6. Devilish Detours: Things that pull you away from God's original plan and path for your life.

7. Defining Destiny: Not just about where you are going, but who you are becoming, according God's divine design for your life.

This is your decisional moment, where you must abandon all delusional misunderstandings. It is here where being sober minded is necessary in order for you to make a momentary decision, to embrace God's purpose and process for your life. This is not a career decision but a life decision, which in truth is the best decision for your life. Life is not about what you become it's more about who you are. In this life you can become
