

What Kind of Faith Do You Have?

Opening Apostolic and Prophetic Statement and Judgement

My words as hard as I know that they are, are not designed to puncture wounds into anyone's confidence, but rather to give punctuational clarity to the incorrect cadences that are governing the character and lives of those who say that they are surrendered to Christ, as a lifestyle. A lot of people have been fooled into believing that the Church is healthy, but it is not. Pastor's Bishops, Apostles, Prophets, Enthusiast, etc., have these local, State and National public forums called the State of the Church. Clergy from different denominational influences, who don't even agree on the ministry of the Holy Spirit, are suppose to come together to opine around subjective ideologies and influences of personal preferences and egotistical perspectives.

If the Ecclesiastical Diaspora had their ears consecrated to the voice of God, and not popular social media opinion, they would know without having to come together and play the egotistical guessing game of whose making the best points. Stop calling for these streaming live round table conversation, and call for a time of real fasting and get on your face before God, without the optics of impressive illusions, and stay their until the Holy Ghost speaks. You see to my own personal surrender, I have been more intentional in my godly pursuit, to bring myself to a place where outside noise and various nuances of what other people feel and think. In doing so, I have accepted the role of being alone without being lonely. I keep telling you all that things are changing rapidly, and there is no time for argumentative assembling, around insignificant things that have nothing to do with what God is saying in this season and time.

Now is the time for real faith filled leaders and believers who are willing to be trained for war, both in the Spirit and in the natural realm. This is why I am challenging you at the level that I am, in behalf of the great I Am. so come and take this walk of faith with me and let me show you a whole new path to perpetual victory. Let me prophecy, that before Thanksgiving I am going to show you some of the fruit from the promised land.

So the question of today is; What kind of Faith do You have?

Mark 5:27-29 KJV

27 When **she had heard** of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment.

28 For **she said**, If I **may touch but his clothes**, I shall be whole.

29 And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and **she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague.**

She heard, she said, she touched and she got healed, and she never asked for permission to touch Him, nor to heal her. She just believed, pursued and received.

Mark 11:22

And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

Introduction: Power that keeps the light on: Agreement, Alignment, Assurance and Activation through Application.

The Principle of Personal Agreement: In the New Testament Greek, one of the words for agreement is the same Greek word I gave to you last Sunday. **symphoneo: to be in harmony with.**

Because God has a plan for your life (not if) you have to come into agreement with it, even when you're not sure what it is.

The Power of Corporate Agreement: People in Covenant with each other around a specific cause, signifies a corporate union.

Matthew 18:19-21

19 "Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.

20 For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.

21 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times?

22 Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven."

This is the place from which we must pray, **harmonious unity**, for this is how the activation of manifestation happens in the Kingdom of God. No other way around it.

(Musicians play out of key and rhythm)

Alignment: Living in harmony and in step with a higher purpose or divine will.

Assurance: Greek word parresia which means a confident boldness in God.

1 John 5:14-15 KJV

“And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:

And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.”

Hebrews 10:35 NLT

“So do not throw away this confident trust in the Lord. Remember the great reward it brings you!”

Activation through Application: The action by which we apply the spoken and written word.

The Principle of Activation through Application

1. Hear and understand the biblical truth

- **Listen to the Word:** Faith comes by hearing the word of God (**Romans 10:17**), which involves more than just listening—it's about hearing a Spirit-quicken word.
- **Seek the truth:** **John 8:32** says, "And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free". Understanding the truth makes you free to believe it.

2. Believe in your heart

- **Internalize the message:** **Romans 10:8-10** states that with the heart one believes. Belief is not just an intellectual exercise, but a matter of the heart.

- **Align with the heart: Matthew 12:34** says, "...out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks". Your heart's belief determines what you will confess.

3. Speak with your mouth

- **Confess the word: Romans 10:8-10** also connects confession with salvation. What you confess with your mouth, based on what you believe in your heart, helps bring it into manifestation.
- **Speak the truth: Psalm 116:10** says, "I believed, therefore I spoke". Speaking words that align with your heart-faith is a key part of activation.

4. Take action

- **Put the word into practice:** The principle of application is about doing what the scripture says, not just reading it. This involves putting the "rubber to the road" with the truth you have received.
- **Let it be a guide for your life:** The Bible instructs believers to be "doers of the word" (**James 1:22**) and to put its teachings into practice in their daily lives, which can include things like following the 10 Commandments, encouraging others, and cultivating the gifts of the Spirit.
- **Embrace the process:** Application is not just about following a list of rules, but about being shaped by God's truth in a practical way. Bible study, prayer, and worship these are the keys.

The Ism's of Faith

Faith must be your present reality, it must be in your now.

Faith is a present insertion into the realm of the now.

Hope is a deferred future expectation, not a present anticipation.

Faith that created the universe is the faith that's within the present re-created believer.

Faith is taking God at his word and acting upon it.

Action says I have confidence in what I know God has said therefore I move in that active faith.

Action is the manifestation of what we say we believe, and what we say, we know. It is our action that gives birth to manifestation, not our asking. If God says something is, then we must act as though we know that it is.

Delayed action is controlled by a deferred fear that has a gripped lock on your confident expectation.

The Isn't's of Faith

Faith is not passive endurance; it is active agreement.

Matthew 17:20 NLT

20 ““You don’t have enough faith,” Jesus told them. “I tell you the truth, if you had faith even as small as a mustard seed, you could say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it would move. Nothing would be impossible.””

Asking can convey uncertainty in the realm of your faith in God. When Jesus said ask and it shall be given, seek and ye shall find, knock and the door will be open to you, that's not begging. That's asking in assured authority, seeking with enthused expectation, knocking at and pushing on the door at the same time.

Faith doesn't wait for anything to manifest before it believes. It believes and watches with the expectation of manifestation.

Waiting for God to move is not faith, it's unbelief and unsettled certainty, hiding behind patience and indecisiveness.

Waiting on a move of God is the declaration of an unawareness to what a move of God is.

There will be no real Revival until there is a Real Visitation of the Spirit of Christ Awakening. Not some committee planned church service. There can be no public corporate visitation until there has been personal and private visitations of the Spirit in your life and space of living. God won't show up for you here if He can't show up for you at your house.

Faith cannot function where the will of God is uncertain.

Romans 12:2 NLT

2 "Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect."

Closing Summary

The analysis of paralysis: the reality that fear controls your decisions, therefore you cannot discern God's directions. When this happens, the delay that you're experiencing is not God's denial but your own deception.

Dishonest devotion: masked spirituality that bears no fruit. The fruit you bear is the truth you wear. When you have no fruit to show, you have no proof that you're doing the work or walking in the truth.

You're not lost, you're scared: You know exactly where you are, you are stuck in the dust of denial. Unfortunately, you just don't know who you are, in the scheme of God's plan. So you become busy at everything, but you end up doing nothing. But here's the catch, people who experience you are impressed, but the truth is, they're never improved by your business.
