KEY TEXT – John 4:4-26

(THE PSALMS) – Read Psalm 95, 100, 150

- What do the psalmists teach us about worship?

- What is the difference between corporate worship and individual worship according to the psalmist?

(HE IS WORTHY) Read Revelation 4:1-11

- What do you imagine when you think of worship in heaven?
- What aspects of John’s vision of heaven, can or should we incorporate into the way we worship God?
- Why is God worthy of our worship?
- What is the value of corporate worship according to John?

(24/7 WORSHIP) Read Romans 12:1-13

- Underline or highlight all the references to worship.
- According to Paul what is worship?
- How does developing a worship lifestyle impact the way we worship the Lord corporately?
- What role does service/ministry play in worship?
- What role does love others deeply play in our worship?
- What is the relationship between our first two big rocks of worship and groups?

(WORSHIP) Read John 4:4-26

- Stop and listen to Brandon’s message if you missed it last week.
- Read John 4 multiple times in multiple translations if possible.
- Highlight keywords or phrases that speak to your heart.
- What were some of the Samaritan woman’s misconceptions about worship? What are some of our misconceptions about worship?
- Brandon talked about the “well” and the “mountain” – as you read this encounter what is your well and what is your mountain? How has your well and mountain enhanced or harmed your perspective of worship?
- True worshippers will worship God in spirit and truth. According to John what does this mean? How can you apply this to your life?
- After reflecting upon this passage, what does John want us to know about God and how we worship him?
- What does John want us to know about us and our hearts as it relates to the way we worship God?
