January 24th, 2022

January 25th, 2022

1 Timothy 5:17 NASB The elders who rule well are to be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who work hard at preaching and teaching.

James 1:22 ESV But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

January 27th, 2022

Joshua 1:7 ESV Only be strong and courageous, being careful to do according to all the law of that Moses my servant commanded you. Do not turn from it to the right hand or the left, that you may have success wherever you go.
