January 18th, 2022

2 Timothy 2:15 NASB Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.

January 19th, 2022

Mark 4:20 NASB And those are the ones on whom seed was sown on the good soil; and they hear the word and accept it and bear fruit, thirty, sixty, and a hundredfold.

January 20th, 2022

Mark 4:24 NLT Then Jesus added, “Pay close attention to what you hear. The closer you listen, the more understanding you will be given and you will receive even more.

January 21st, 2022

1 Thessalonians 2:13 NIV And we also thank God continually because, when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men, but as it is, the word of God, which is at work in you who believe.

January 22nd, 2022

James 1:22 ESV But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

January 23rd, 2022

Colossians 1:25 NET I became a servant of the church according to the stewardship from God – given to me for you –to complete the word of God.

January 24th, 2022

Colossians 1:28 NLT So we tell others about Christ, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all the wisdom God has given us. We want to present them to God, perfect in their relationship to Christ.

January 25th, 2022

1 Timothy 5:17 NASB The elders who rule well are to be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who work hard at preaching and teaching.

READ MARK 1:16-28:

- In what ways did Jesus teach with authority? Why was Jesus’s teaching different than the scribes? How would you describe the authority of God’s Word as it relates to your own life?
