

## The Case for Goodness

1. We are saved by grace not by works.

Ephesians 2:8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith — and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— 9 not by works, so that no one can boast.

2. We are saved to do good works.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Matthew 5:16 In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.

What does it mean to "Let your light shine?"

1. We think the best life is to "tell people off."

The better life is to overlook an offense.

Proverbs 19:11 A man's wisdom gives him patience; it is to his glory to overlook an offense.

2. We think the best life is to strike back, harder.

The better life is to turn the other cheek.

Matthew 5:39 But I tell you, Do not resist an evil person. If someone strikes you on the right cheek, turn to him the other also.

3. We think the best life is to stand your ground.

The better life is to go the extra mile.

Matthew 5:41 If someone forces you to go one mile, go with him two miles.

4. We think the best life is watching your enemy fail.

The better life is helping your enemy succeed.

Romans 12:20 . . . "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head."

21 Do not be overcome by evil but overcome evil with good.
