Of the 34 times the word “overcome” is used in the New Testament, it’s used 17 times in the book of Revelation.

Revelation 2:7 “*To him who overcomes, I will grant to eat of the tree of life which is in the Paradise of God.*”

Revelation 22:2 “*On either side of the river was the tree of life, bearing twelve kinds of fruit...*”

Revelation 22:16 “*I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star.*”

Revelation 13:7 “*It was also given to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them, and authority over every tribe and people and tongue and nation was given to him.*”

2. Future believers will rejoice in their martyrdom.

Revelation 12:11-12 “*And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death. For this reason, rejoice, O heavens and you who dwell in them.*”
