KEY TEXT – Matthew 9:35-38

“The harvest is plentiful and the workers are few” Matthew 9:38

Read Matthew 9:35-10:15

- Read through this passage 2 or 3 times.
- Which verse(s) speaks to you the most?
- Which words or phrases are repeated for emphasis?
- What is the main idea of Jesus’s teaching?
- What are 2 or 3 principles that you can apply to your life?

Missional Living (Matthew 9:35-10:15)

- According to Jesus what does missional living look like for a disciple?
- Why did Jesus send out the disciples?
- Who did Jesus call to be the first missionaries?
- What did Jesus want them to do specifically as laborers?
- Where did Jesus want them to go first? Why?
- How did Jesus want them to behave as they interacted with people?
- On a scale of 1 to 10, how would you rate your compassion for others who are far from God?
- In what ways are people harassed and helpless today?
- In what ways has the Lord called you to be one of his disciples?
- “Go” is repeated three times in verses 10:5-7! Where is he asking you to “go” in your own life?
- Why did Jesus send the disciples to the lost sheep of Israel first?
- How does this commission compare to the commission in Matthew 28:18-20? What’s the major difference between the two?
- How does Matthew 10:11-13 apply to today? Is there a person of peace in your life, who welcomes you but has not yet accepted Christ as their Savior? What is your next step if so?

Missions and Outreach in Scripture

- Read Psalm 67 – what is the purpose behind our blessings?
- Read Jonah – in what ways is your heart like Jonah’s heart?
- Read John 4:31-42– what are the lessons to be learned here?
- Read John 9:24-41 – how does the blind man become missional?
- Read Matthew 28:18-20 – memorize this verse.
- Read Acts 1:8 – according to Jesus what is a witness?
- Read Colossians 4:2-6 – how do these instructions help us?
- Read 2 Timothy 4:5 – what is the work of an evangelist?

Weekend Message

- Stop and Listen to the weekend message if you missed it or need to refresh yourself.

- In what ways are you a consumer of the Chapel? In what ways are you a contributor to the Chapel?

STEP #1 SEE
