January 1st, 2022

Psalm 1:2 NLT But they delight in the law of the Lord, meditating on it day and night.

January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022

Psalm 119:11 NASB Your word I have treasured in my heart, that I may not sin against you.

January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022

2 Timothy 3:16 NLT All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.

January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022

**2 Timothy 4:2 NIV** Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage – with great patience and careful instruction.

January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022

Ezra 7:10 ESV For Ezra had set his heart to study the Law of the Lord, and to do it and to teach his statutes and rules in Israel.

January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022

Psalm 19:7 MSG The revelation of God is whole and pulls our lives together. The signposts of God are clear and point out the right road.

January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022

**Psalm 19:8 NET** The Lord's precepts are fair and make one joyful. The Lord's commands are pure and give insights into life.

January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022

**Psalm 19:9 NIV** The fear of the Lord is pure, enduring forever. The ordinances of the Lord are sure and altogether righteous.
