Question 2: How did communion get started?

1. something old: Passover and Feast of Unleavened Bread

Exodus 12:8 *That evening everyone must eat roast lamb with bitter herbs and bread made without yeast.* NLT

Exodus 12:14 *"You must remember this day forever. Each year you will celebrate it as a special festival to the LORD. 15 For seven days, you may eat only bread made without yeast.* NLT

2. became something new: Communion

Question 3: Why do we have this tradition?

1. to remember Christ's death for us
