John 17:17 (ESV) *"Sanctify them in the truth. Your work is truth."*

Proverbs 3:5-6 (ESV) *Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.*

Repentance involves sorrow, confession, and change.

The Bible trains us for righteousness by revealing necessary exercises.

1 Corinthians 9:25-27 (ESV) *Every athlete exercises self-control in all things. They do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable. So I do not run aimlessly; I do not box as one beating the air. But I discipline my body and keep it under control, lest after preaching to others I myself should be disqualified.*

Philippians 2:12 – 13 (ESV) *Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.*

If you want God to energize your transformation, you need to put in some energy.

Acts 2:42 (ESV) *And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.*

The barrier between you and a changed life is a changed schedule.

Sanctification Irreducible Minimums

- 15 minutes in the Bible daily
- 15 minutes in prayer daily
- Listen to practical teaching weekly
- Meet intentionally with others weekly
