The New Testament often compares the Christian journey to running and completing a race. Read the following passages and make a list of observations of keys to running the race (progressing along the path):

- I Corinthians 9:24-26
- Philippians 3:8-15
- Hebrews 12:1-17
- 2 Timothy 4:7-8

One major warning to Christians concerns the problem of not growing up in our faith, and not progressing down the path toward maturity. Read the following passages:

- I Corinthians 3:1-15
- Hebrews 5:11-6:2

How do these warnings against staying stuck in spiritual infancy speak about where you are at on your journey of faith?

God’s goal for our lives as believers is that we grow up into maturity in our character and our conduct. Read the following passages that describe the call and path to maturity:

- Acts 2:42-47
- Romans 6:1-14
- Romans 8:28-30
- Romans 12:1-2
- Galatians 5:16-26
- Ephesians 4:11-16
- Ephesians 4:17-32

What are several of the keys to spiritual growth that you observe in these passages that you need to embrace as in your spiritual journey?
