#### (Warning Passage) Hebrews 5:11-6:2

- How would you describe the warning in your own words?
- What does "dull of hearing" mean to you?
- What are the basic principles for us today?
- Would you say you drink milk or eat meat spiritually?
- How can you become more skilled in the Word of God?
- What is the exhortation for us today?
- How well can you discern good from evil?
- Is there any friend or family member you can encourage to grow spiritually and to eat from meat?
