

inAction steps

- 1. Someone else will take care of it.
- 2. I don't have much to offer.

Mark 6:35-36 And when it grew late, his disciples came to him and said, "This is a desolate place, and the hour is now late. 36 Send them away to go into the surrounding countryside and villages and buy themselves something to eat."

inAction says, "Let someone else take care of them."

Mark 6:37 But he answered them, "You give them something to eat."

in-Action says, "I'm called to do what I can."

Mark 6:37-38 And they said to him, "Shall we go and buy two hundred denarii worth of bread and give it to them to eat?" 38 And he said to them, "How many loaves do you have? Go and see." And when they had found out, they said, "Five, and two fish."

inAction says, "I don't have much to offer."

Mark 6:41 And taking the five loaves and the two fish, he looked up to heaven and said a blessing and broke the loaves and gave them to the disciples to set before the people. And he divided the two fish among them all.

in-Action says, "I'm giving Jesus what I have."

- 1. You may not have much to give, yet you have so much to offer.
- 2. God serves directly with people who serve directly with people.
- 3. You're not called to be adequate. You're called to be obedient.

I'm inadequate and that's ok. But God is adequate, so I'll obey.
