Call to Prayer for 2026

Main Topic: The Centrality of Prayer for Church Victory

- **Key Points:**

- The importance of seeking God's direction and relying on Him daily was emphasized, using testimonies of personal dependence and God's faithfulness.

- The need to forgive others as part of effective prayer was

emphasized.

- The privilege of approaching God's throne boldly through Jesus and praying in His name was explained, with references to

Hebrews and John.

- The Holy Spirit's role in helping us pray, especially when we don't know what to say, was mentioned.
- The necessity of aligning prayers with God's will by knowing Scripture and praying biblical promises was stressed.

- **Questions Raised:**

- Are we truly dedicating enough time to prayer, or just going through the motions?
- Are we approaching God with the right attitude and faith in His authority?
- Do we understand the spiritual opposition to increased prayer and the importance of persistence?

- **Decisions Made:**

- The church is called to increase and deepen its practice of prayer in 2026.
- There is a renewed focus on corporate and individual prayer, including more time for personal listening and reflection.

- **Action Plans:**

- Members are encouraged to set aside daily quiet time for prayer, reducing distractions like TV and phones.
- The church will continue to support prayer teams and encourage participation in prayer and discipleship activities.
- Congregants are urged to forgive others, align their prayers with God's will, and pray boldly in Jesus' name.

- The altars are open for prayer, and elders are available to pray

Additional Topics

Spiritual Warfare and the Need for Vigilance

- The congregation was warned that spiritual opposition will increase as the church prioritizes prayer.
- Members are encouraged to pray for protection from temptation and the evil one, following Jesus' teaching in the Lord's Prayer.
- The importance of not neglecting prayer in favor of less important activities was underscored.

Vision for a Spirit-Filled Church

- The pastor expressed a desire for the church to be known for the presence and power of the Holy Spirit, with signs, wonders, and transformed lives.
