personal and generational blessing.

- **Questions Raised:**

- Are we truly allowing God to govern every aspect of our lives?
- How can we grow in submission and trust each day?
- What does it look like to trust God with our future, family, and resources?

- **Decisions Made:**

- Commitment to increasing daily submission to God's authority.
- Decision to trust God's report over human reports or fears.

- **Action Plans:**

- Spend time in prayer, asking God to take charge and remove anxieties about the future.
- Hide God's Word in the heart to resist sin and remain faithful.
- Practice giving concerns to God and trust Him to work all things for good (Romans 8:28).
- Encourage others to do the same, seeking revival and spiritual renewal within the community.

## **Additional Topics:**

- **Reflections on National Division:**

- The speaker notes the problem of division and hatred in the country, relating it to leaders' inability to get along and calling for believers to look to a higher authority for unity and peace.

- **Role of the Holy Spirit:**

- Emphasizes the often-neglected role of the Holy Spirit in guiding and empowering believers, not to be feared but embraced

and empowering members, not to be feared but embraced.

- **Call to Action:**

- The meeting ends with an invitation to prayer, encouraging participants to surrender their worries and trust in God's governance for themselves and their families.
