### **Babies and Toddlers**

God takes care of us. People should only worship God. God's people worshiped a calf made of gold. Moses asked God to forgive the people. God forgives people through Jesus.

#### Preschool

What is God's plan? God's plan is to rescue His people. God's people worshiped a golden calf.

#### Kids

What is God's plan? God's plan is to rescue His people from captivity. God punished His people for worshiping a golden calf.

## THE GOLDEN CALF ACTIVITY: SLAP CALF

### \*2 players needed.

INSTRUCTION

\*Print out calfs on next page.

STORY CONNECTION

- \*Give each pair 10 plastic cups, masking tape, a golden calf, and a foam ball.
- \*Direct kids to use masking tape to affix the golden calf to one cup.
- \*Guide kids to construct a triangle-shaped structure with plastic cups. Tell kids to start with four cups on the bottom row, three cups in the next row, and then two cups in the next row.
- \*Tell kids to place the cup with the golden calf at the top of the pyramid. Instruct kids to stand several feet away and try to use the ball to knock down the golden calf.

### MATERIALS

10 plastic cups
masking tape
foam balls
