



Dear Parents,

This week, we continued our journey through the Bible using The Gospel Project® for Kids and examined the rules that God gave His people for how to worship Him in the tabernacle. God required sacrifices from the people when they sinned. The book of Hebrews tells us that the sacrifices themselves did not save the people, but it was their faith in the Sacrifice of Jesus who was to come that saved them.

Help your kids realize that Jesus is the ultimate and perfect Sacrifice and salvation is found in Him alone.

FAMILY STARTING POINTS

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GOD GAVE RULES FOR SACRIFICE

ACTIVITY: PAID IN FULL

INSTRUCTIONS

- * Give each child a piece of white paper. Direct the kids to write down a few sins they have committed this week.
- * Mention that sin is breaking God's law. Offer suggestions such as lying, disobeying parents, saying mean words, wanting something that doesn't belong to them, worshiping something or someone other than God, being selfish, and so forth. Give the kids several minutes to make their lists.
- * Invite them to pray and ask God to bring sins to mind.
- * Say: Look at your paper. Who can keep God's law? No one can keep God's law perfectly except Jesus. Your sin separates you from God. God is holy and can't be around sin. Today we learned that because God gave the Israelites rules for sacrifice. Because God is holy, God requires a sacrifice for sin.
- * Now have kids crumple up their paper.
- * Say: Jesus died on the cross as the ultimate sacrifice for our sin. Jesus never sinned! But He took our place and paid the punishment for our sin.
- * Exchange each kid's crumpled paper for a piece of blank white paper.
- * SAY • When we trust in Jesus, He gives us His righteousness. God forgives our sin and gives us eternal life. We will live with Him forever!

Big Picture Question: Who can keep God's law? No one can keep God's law perfectly except Jesus.

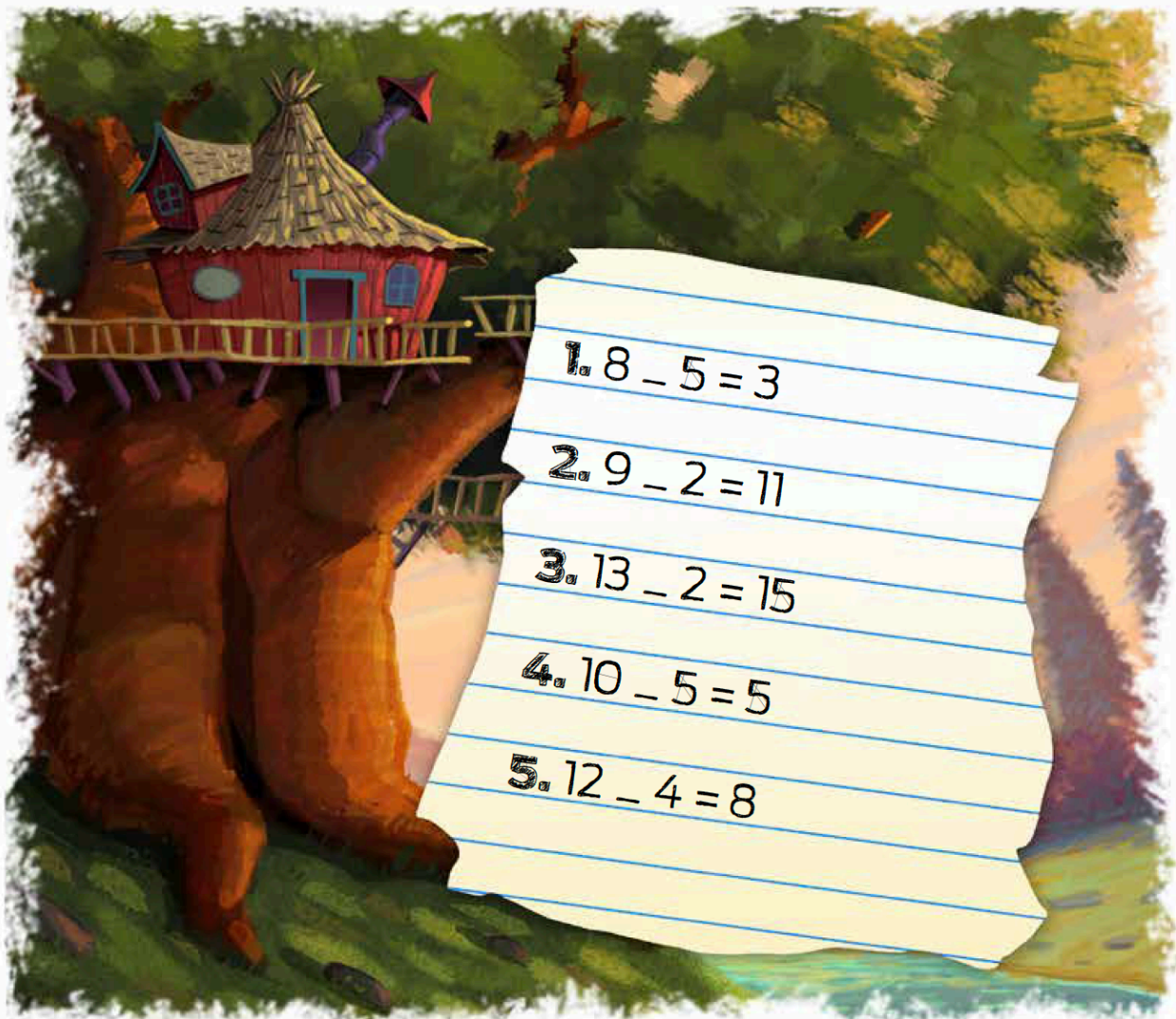

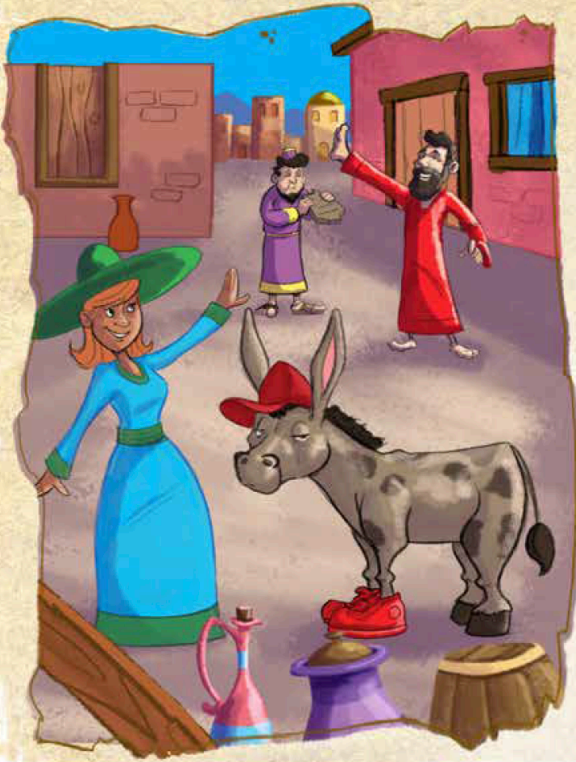
