Reflection The harlot/prostitute is symbolically named Babylon in the Old Testament empire that destroyed Jerusalem and took God's people into exile. In Revelation Babylon represents the Roman Empire which was actively persecuting God's people in John's day. What do you think the prostitute Babylon represents today?

What are the prostitutes sins? Do you think that John is talking about literal physical adultery or are there other ways that people commit adultery with Babylon?
