ACTIVITY: FAITHFULNESS FRAME

INSTRUCTIONS

- *Provide each kid a half-sheet of paper and markers.
- *Invite kids to write the main point on the top of the page.
- *Encourage kids to write down or draw a picture of some of the wonderful things God has done for them, and then use the craft sticks and art supplies to make a frame.
- *You may need to assist younger kids with gluing the frame to the kids' artwork. Set it aside to dry.
- *Take your beautiful frames home and display it somewhere you will see it every day this week. Each time you look at it, remember how God has been faithful to you. Remember that we worship God because the Lord alone is God; there is no other besides Him.

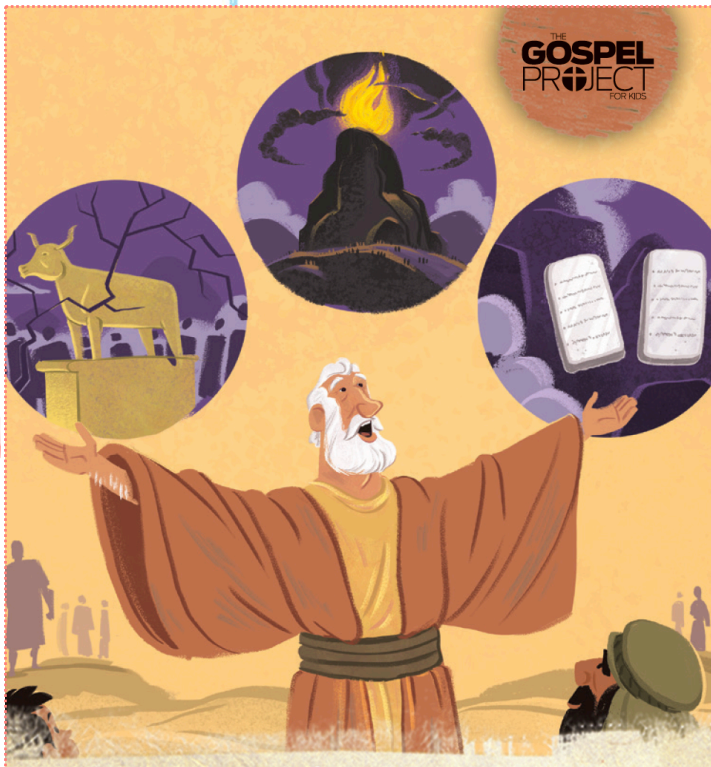
