In this passage God emphasizes the importance of killing and participating in animal sacrifice. Is this passage about how God wants us to cook our meat? Does God really care on whether we order our steak rare or medium well? In Leviticus 17:11 we discover that life is in the blood. This is a concept in which science explains only 1000's of years after God's word claims it. This verse establishes guidelines for how God feels about His creation signifying the importance of blood and life. "In today's fast-paced world, it's easy to lose sight of the value of human life. From casual violence in video games to desensitization to tragedy in the media, the significance of each person's existence is often overlooked. In fact, some people in today's society value their pets more than people. In a society where human life is often devalued, God reminds us that it's crucial to uphold the sanctity of life.
