# THE TABERNACLE WAS BUILT

**ACTIVITY: MAKE A YARN TENT** 

- \*Invite students to use glue and yarn to outline the shape of a tent on a piece of construction paper.
- \*Invite kids to use crayons, colored pencils, or markers to decorate their tent.
- \*While kids draw, remind kids about the materials and hard work that went into building the tabernacle just as God described. (Exodus 35:4—40:38)
- SAY •The tabernacle looked similar to a tent. It was always located in the center of the Israelites' camp as they made their way through the wilderness and into the Promised Land. God told His people to build the tabernacle so He could dwell with them.


Exodus 35:4-40:38

Big Picture Question: Who can keep God's law? No one can keep God's law perfectly except Jesus.


