The book of Ephesians begins like many letters of the first century. It has an identification of the author, the recipients, and a greeting, but this is no ordinary letter. Ephesians unveils your identity rooted in Christ and the profound blessings that flow from this relationship. Paul establishes the context addressing believers as the "saints" indicating their identity as set apart and devoted followers of Christ. It is easy to get lost on the theological debates in this passage on predestination, but don't miss the beauty of it. Paul celebrates how God, chose believers in Christ even before the creation of the world. This means He chose you! This divine act shapes a believers identity as God's beloved and adopted children, lavished with spiritual blessings. Please take the time to read Ephesians 1:1-14 as a group and then discuss the following questions.
