## Icebreaker

This past Sunday Pastor Chris said he believes Adam and Eve ate a mango in the Garden of Eden because he would not sin for an apple. What type of fruit do you believe they ate?

## Passage 1 **Genesis 3:1-6**

**Reflection** What was the serpent trying to accomplish in his exchange with the woman? What strategy did he use?

In Genesis 3:4, the serpent calls God a liar- "you will not die" he says' and proceeds to tell the woman why it will be to her benefit to disobey God. What are these supposed benefits?

In this passage Satan tempts Adam and Eve to doubt in God's provision. How do you trust God in situations where you don't see his provision?

## Passage 2 **1 Corinthians 10:13**

**Reflection** What does this verse say about temptation? How do you resist temptations?

## Passage 3 **Matthew 4:1-4**

**Reflection** How did Jesus resist temptation? On a scale from 1-10, how well do you know your Bible? What is your favorite Bible verse?

**Passage 4**    **Genesis 3:6-7**

**Reflection**    What is sin and how would you describe it? How did Adam and Eve sin against God?

What immediate effects did Adam and Eve's disobedience have that can be seen in their behavior? What are the consequences of their sin? How does their sin effect us today?

**Passage 5**    **Genesis 3:21**

**Reflection**    Did God abandon his disobedient children? What sacrifice did God make to cloth his children? How does this verse point us to Jesus?  
(Hint: John 3:16)

**Application**

Adam and Eve chose to chase after creation instead of the creator. What commitment can you make this week to chase after God?
