## message summary

Have doubts ever clouded your faith, and made you feel inadequate in serving God? God's selection isn't based on our perceived abilities, but on our willingness to obey and let His power flow through us. In this passage God instructs Moses to ordain Aaron and his sons. The text does not list anything that Aaron or his sons do in order to deserve this responsibility. If you have ever felt like you are not qualified in order to do to represent God or minister to others, you are not alone. Some have even suggested that they were selected just because they were related to Moses. Moses follows specific instructions from God to consecrate them for their sacred duties in the tabernacle. The ceremony involves ritual purification, anointing with oil, and offering sacrifices. This chapter highlights Moses, who was functioning as Israel's priest passing the torch to Aaron and his sons. Let's read Leviticus 8:1-36 together and see how we can apply things to our lives because we are God's priesthood today over His household.
