
## message sumary

Christmas season is a time of year where love is expressed through the giving of gifts. In this passage the apostle John writes to us that the greatest of these gifts is that Jesus took on flesh and blood and stepped into the world in order to dwell with His people. God steps onto His own canvas in order to demonstrate His love for us. In a world that overly emphasizes that you can fall in and out of love the apostle John teaches that love is much more than a feeling. The apostle says in order to really know what true love is we need to look toward Jesus and how He demonstrated love by laying down his life for us. The apostle says that followers of Jesus show this same type of love to others. He underscores the inseparable connection between loving one another and knowing God. Let's read 1 John 4:7-21 and see how our love for others is a demonstration of our relationship with God.
