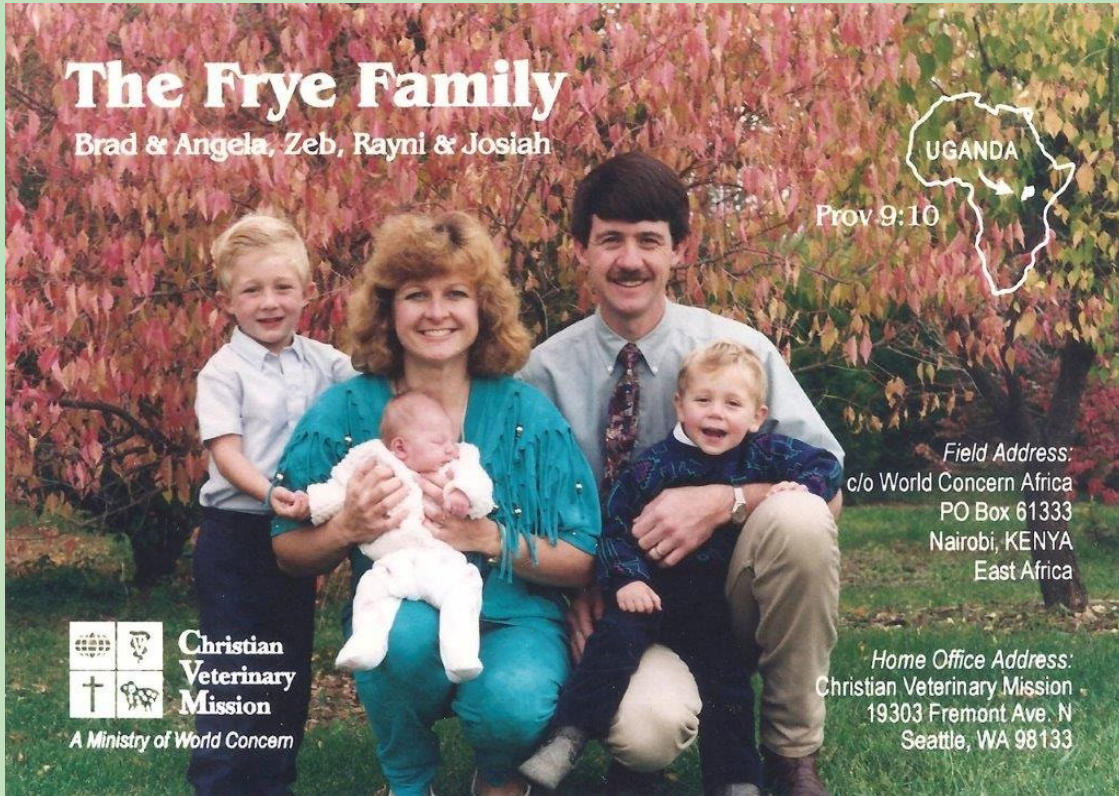

# Why Missions? God's Plan and Heart - Abrahamic Covenant

- Gen 12:2 And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. 3 I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you **all the families of the earth shall be blessed.**
- (1) the national promises given to Israel;
- (2) the personal promises given to Abraham;
- (3) the principle of blessing or cursing upon nations other than Israel based on their attitude toward Abraham and his seed;
- (4) the promise of **universal blessing through Abraham**, fulfilled through Christ.

# God's heart - Blessing fulfilled in Christ

---

- Math 1:17 So all the generations from **Abraham** to David were fourteen generations, and from David to the deportation to Babylon fourteen generations, and from the deportation to Babylon **to the Christ** fourteen generations.
- Gal 3:25 But now that faith has come, we are no longer under a guardian, 26 for **in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith.** 27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. 28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. 29 **And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's** offspring, heirs according to promise.
- Gal 5:6 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only **faith working through love.**

# Why Missions? – Great Commission

---

- Mathew 28:18 And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 **Go** therefore and make disciples of **all nations**, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

# Why Missions - Go

- Acts 1: 8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”
- “The Great Commission is not an option to be considered; it is a command to be obeyed.” Hudson Taylor





# Why Missions – The Great Command

- Gal 5:14 or the whole law is fulfilled in one word: “You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”
- Mark 12 & Math 22:3 a lawyer, asked him a question to test him. 36 “Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?” 37 And he said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. 38 This is the great and first commandment. 39 And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. 40 On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets.”



# Why Missions – The Great Command

- 1 John 3:16 By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers. 17 But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's love abide in him? 18 Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth.
