How to love what you do

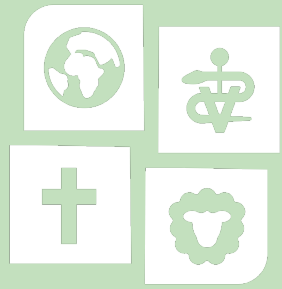
What is fulfilling about what you do?

- It is easy to do this, once a decision to do it has been made

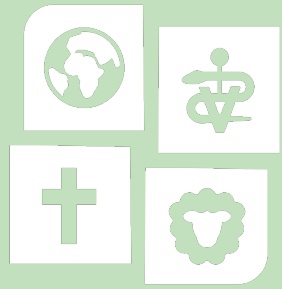




Intersection of These 2 Concepts

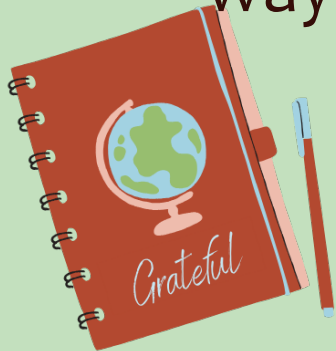
- When you love what you do

Give Your Best at Work

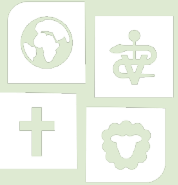
- Be fully present

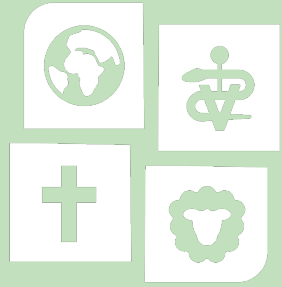

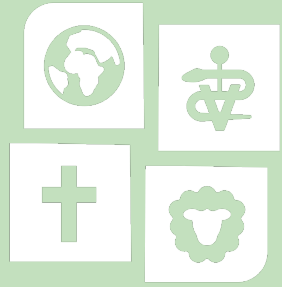

Why focus on work/life balance?

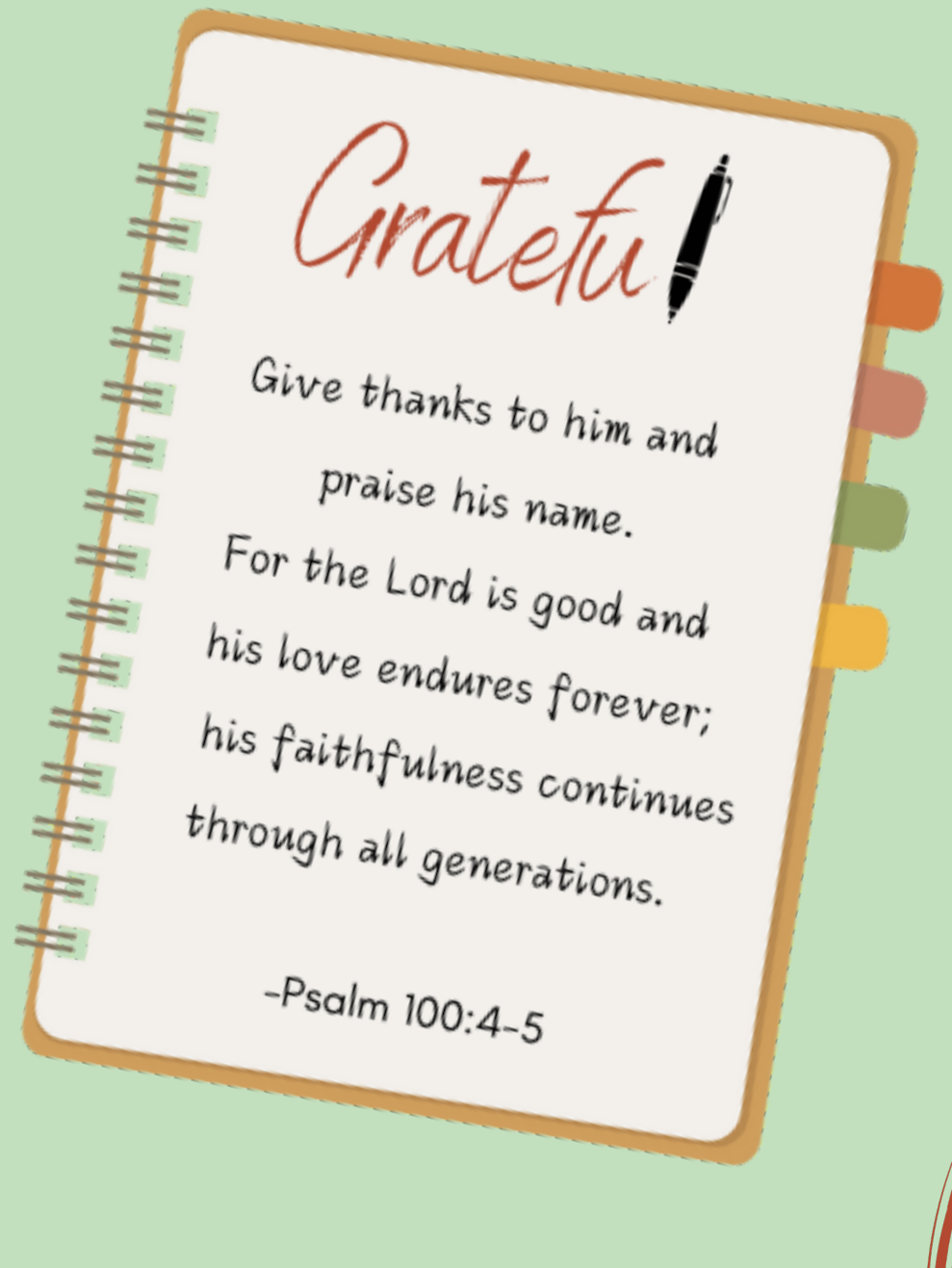
- What does this mean?
