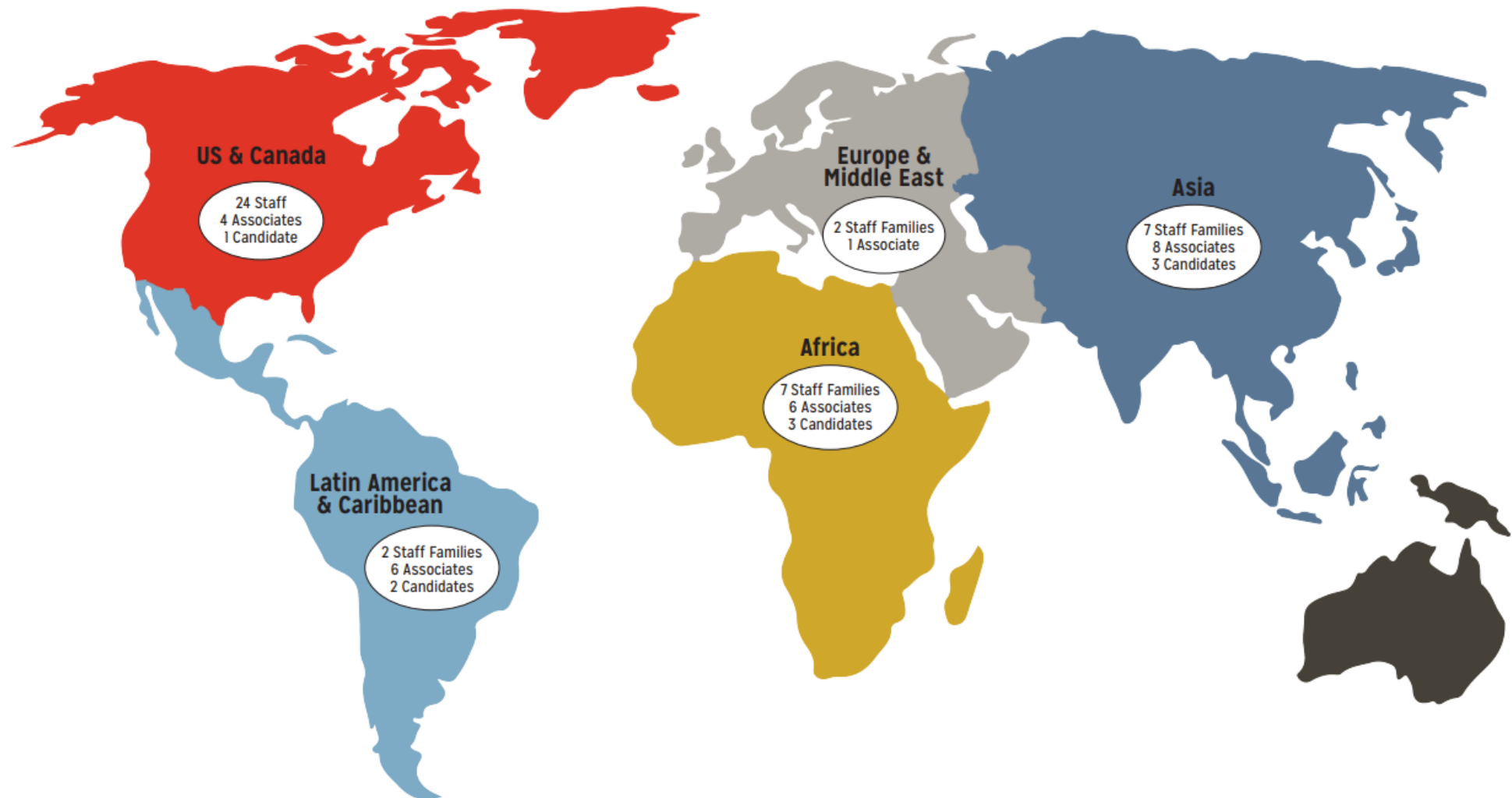

Where?



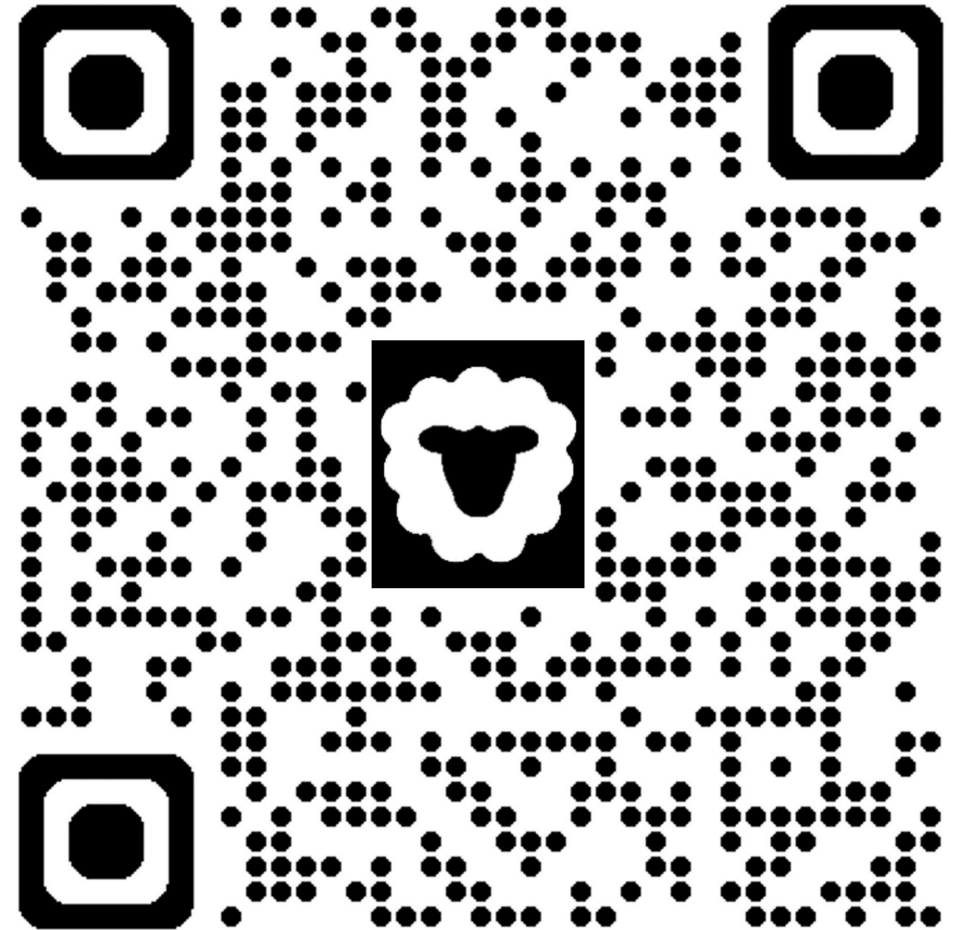
- Where people have limited access to the Gospel

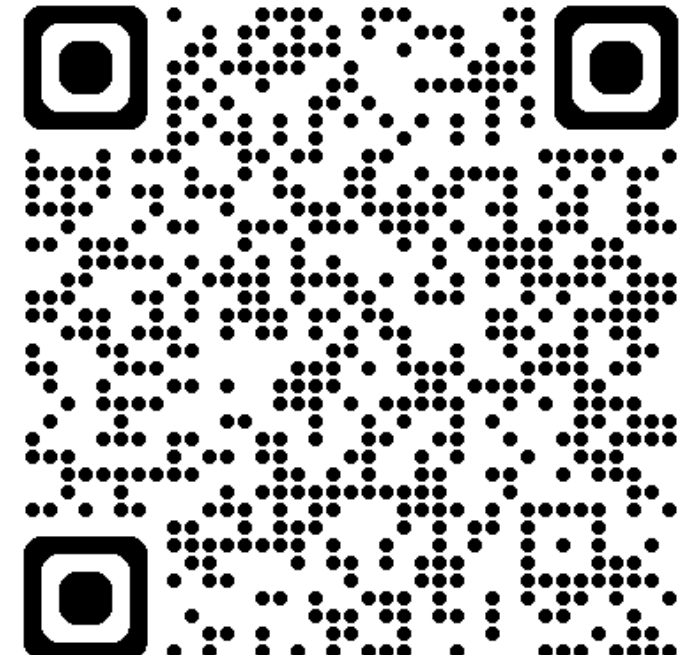

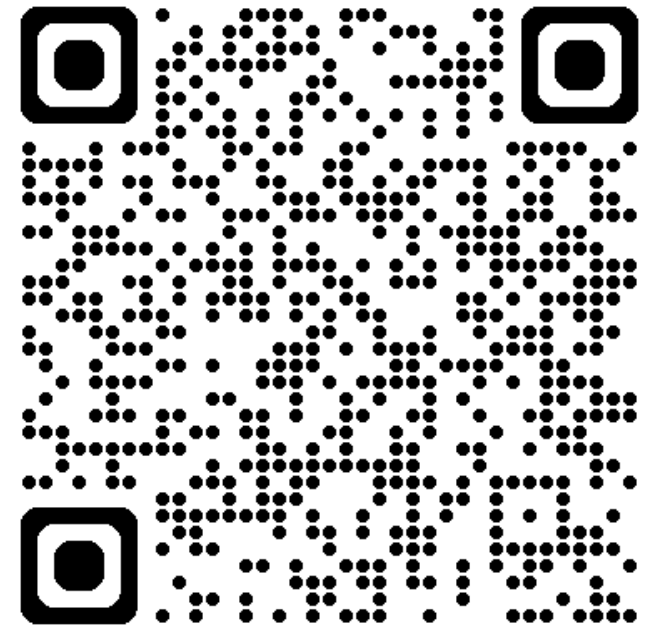
