"And you will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth, ¹⁵ for he will be great before the Lord. And he must not drink wine or strong drink, and he will be filled with the <u>Holy Spirit</u>, even from his mother's womb." Luke 1:14–15 (ESV)

"And the angel answered her, "The <u>Holy Spirit</u> will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy—the Son of God." Luke 1:35 (ESV)
