

Hillside Prayer Guide

Monday:

Pray for your closest circle- family, household, and place of work.

Joshua 24:15 “And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the LORD, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.”

Numbers 6:22-27 “The Lord spoke to Moses, saying, “Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying, Thus you shall bless the people of Israel: you shall say to them,

The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace.

“So shall they put my name upon the people of Israel, and I will bless them.”

Tuesday:

Pray for your city. Pray the “Team” prayer, when a team wins a game, the city also claims that victory. When the few are obedient, the masses receive the victory too. Thursday:
