5th Kingdom >>> Expanding Stone = Grace (70 A.D.)

"While you were watching, a rockwas cut out, but not by human hands. It struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and smashed them. The Everlasting Kingdom

Daniel 2:44-45

"And in the days of those kings the **God of heaven** will <u>set up a kingdom</u> that shall **never be destroyed**, nor shall the kingdom be left to another people. It shall break in pieces all these kingdoms and <u>bring them to an end</u>, and it shall **stand forever**, just as you saw that a stone was cut from a mountain by no human hand, and that it broke in pieces the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver, and the gold. A great God has made known to the king what shall be after this. The dream is certain, and its interpretation sure."

Birth of a King

Isaiah 9:6-7

For to us **a child** is <u>born</u>, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. **He will reign** <u>on David's throne</u> and over <u>his kingdom</u>, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever.

Death of The King

John 18:35-37

Pilate: "Your own people and chief priests handed you over to me. What is it you have done?" **Jesus:** "My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my

arrest by the Jewish leaders. But now my kingdom is from another place."

Pilate: "You are a king, then!"

Jesus: "You say that I am a king. In fact, the reason I was born and came into the world is to testify to the truth. Everyone on the side of truth listens to me."
