The Revelation of Jesus Christ!

Revelation 1:1-3

The revelation from Jesus Christ, which God gave him to show his servants what must **soon take place**. He made it known by sending his angel to his servant John, who testifies to everything he saw—that is, the word of God and the testimony of Jesus Christ. **Blessed** is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear it and take to heart what is written in it, <u>because **the time is near**</u>.

Soon? Really?

Revelation 22

Verse 6: The Lord, the God who inspires the prophets, sent his angel to show his

servants the things that must **soon** take place.

Verse 7: "Look, I am coming soon!"

Verse 10: "Do not seal up the words of the prophecy of this scroll, because the time

is **near.**"

Verse 12: "Look, I am coming soon!"

Verse 20: "Yes, I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.

Daniel's Son of Man

Daniel 7:13-14

"In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one <u>like</u> a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence. He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed."

The Son of Man

Matthew 24:30-34

"Then will appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven. And then all the peoples of the earth will mourn when they see the Son of Man <u>coming on the clouds of heaven</u>, with power and great glory. .. Truly I tell you, <u>this generation will certainly not pass</u> away until all these things have happened."

His Judgement Coming

Revelation 1:5-7

To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood, and has **made us** to be <u>a kingdom and priests</u> to serve his God and Father—to him be glory and power for ever and ever! Amen. "Look, <u>he is coming with the clouds</u>," and "every eye will see him, even those who pierced him"; and all peoples on earth "will mourn because of him." So shall it be! Amen.

A prophecy against Egypt: See, **the Lord rides on a swift cloud** and is coming to Egypt. The idols of Egypt tremble before him, and the hearts of the Egyptians melt with fear.

Revelation 11:15

The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said: "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Messiah, and he will reign for ever and ever."

The Worthy King (Heavenly Coronation)

Revelation 5:7-10

He went and took the scroll from the right hand of him who sat on the throne. And when he had taken it, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb... And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain, and with your blood you purchased for God persons from every tribe and language and people and nation. You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to serve our God, and they will reign on the earth."
