## **Joseph's First Christmas**

Matthew 1:18-21

- <sup>18</sup> This is how the <u>birth of Jesus the Messiah</u> came about: His mother Mary was <u>pledged</u> to be <u>married</u> to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit.
- <sup>19</sup> Because <u>Joseph her **husband**</u> was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to **divorce** her quietly.
- <sup>20</sup> But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. <sup>21</sup> She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name **Jesus**, because he will save his people from their sins."

"The virginal conception has regularly been understood as a way by which Jesus could be both fully human and fully divine. His father, in essence, was God, through the work of the Holy Spirit; his mother was the fully human woman, Mary.

As **fully God**, Jesus was able to pay the eternal penalty for our sins for which finite humanity could not atone.

As **fully human** he could be our adequate representative and substitutionary sacrifice."

## **A Planned Pregnancy**

Matthew 1:22-25

<sup>22</sup> All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: <sup>23</sup> "The **virgin** will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him **Immanuel**" (which means "God with us"). <sup>Isaiah 7:14</sup>

<sup>24</sup> When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife. <sup>25</sup> But he did not consummate their marriage until she gave birth to a son. And he gave him the name **Jesus**.

"Matthew wants to emphasize that Jesus, as God, is 'with us'; deity is immanent. Too often those who have rightly contended for Jesus' full deity have created a God to whom they do not feel close, rather than one who became human in every way like them but without sin.

As God 'with us,' Jesus enables us to come boldly before God's throne when we accept the forgiveness of sins he made available and develop an intimate relationship with him."
