SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read Matthew 9:35-36. How does this relate to what we are experiencing today? Talk about how you may feel "harassed and helpless" (ex. In your family, neighborhood, school or business)

2. Clyde talked about "sheep without a shepherd". Imagine what "sheep without a shepherd" looks like. How might a good shepherd take care of his flock? (Ezekiel 34:16)

3. Jesus calls himself the "good shepherd" (John 10:11). How did Jesus serve his flock? What were some of the things he said or did? Discuss how we can draw hope and encouragement today, knowing that Jesus is our good shepherd.

4. What is Jesus commanding his followings in Matthew 9:38?
 - a. Discuss how this is still relevant to our prayer life today.
 - b. Jesus often answers this prayer by sending his church to serve. How does it make you feel knowing that Jesus wants you to help by serving others?

5. With all that is happening today, many people are feeling helpless and afraid. Discuss how we can experience and share; hope, peace and joy, knowing God empowers us by His Holy Spirit. (Romans 15:13)

6. Knowing that God is calling us to serve, create a specific action plan that you and your family can carry out this week.
