God is Not Finished Yet. Plan B is NOT an Option Prophet Cory Smith

The Issachar Anointing allows men/women to discern the seasons and times. We are in a shifting season. God is beginning to move by his Spirit in unprecedented ways and shifts are taking place in the atmosphere. Because the power of God is about to hit your life like never before, it is imperative that you keep your heart, posture, mind, and emotions in check. The prophecies concerning your destiny are coming off the shelf. While you are warring for your prophecy, there are some things to keep in mind.

- ⇒ God is not a man that He should lie, nor the son of man that He should repent.
- ⇒ God is a covenant keeping God. He is in covenant with you.
- ⇒ God's word will not return void.
- ⇒ The anointing is not free.
- ⇒ The Lord's mercy keeps us from being consumed.
- ⇒ Stay in the secret place of God.
- ⇒ God is our audience.

Conditions of God's Covenant Offering

- Give up your secret sin(s).
- God must have your undivided attention.
- You must be able to hear God's voice.
- Repent

Isaiah 55: 1 – 13

- When an individual doesn't have a relationship with God, he/she may spend money on things that gratify the flesh. Although the flesh is temporary gratified, the Spirit is not. God makes us an offer that we can't refuse. Money is not required for God's offering, but relationship and understanding His word is in the fine print of the offering.
 - During the course of your day, are you consistently gratifying the flesh or the Spirit?
 - If you are gratifying the flesh, create a plan of action (for each fleshly action) to allow your Spirit man to be successful in that area of your life.
 - If you are gratifying your Spirit man, do you seek opportunities to help others

become victorious in the area(s) you overcame?

- God's word will not return void! The word will produce what it is called to do. Our circumstances don't dictate whether the word will produce. Our words produce actions. We have to say it until we see it.
 - What words (scriptures) are you speaking to your circumstance(s)?
 - Are you consistent in your speech?
 - Are you allowing people who think or speak opposite of what you are believing to speak into your hearing?
 - Whose report do you believe?
- As we move from one season to another, we must discern the season and time we are in. It is because of the Lord's mercy that we are not consumed. We cannot be consumed by our circumstances, nor can we allow people to interfere with what God is doing in us or through us in this season. God is the author and finisher of our faith.
- The anointing, not a title, destroys yolks. There is a price for the anointing. Our flesh must die to receive the oil on our life. God is blessed when you do it despite your flesh.
 - Are you willing to pay for the oil on your life?
 - Are you trying to get "Louis Vuitton Oil" for a Walmart price?

2 Peter 3:9

- God changes not. His promises are yes and amen. As a believer, you must war for the word that has been spoken over your life. Plan B is not an option.
- God's sheep know His voice. We must tune into the frequency of heaven so we can hear from God. If God is repeating Himself to you, you are too far away.
 - When was the last time you heard from God?
 - Was your last word a repeated word?
