Sons In Demonstration Recognizing Your Position Apostle Tony Wade

Demonstration is the action or process of showing the existence or truth of something by giving proof or evidence. God wants to prove His existence through His sons. Being a son of God is not based on gender, it's a position. When someone is born again, he/she is considered to be a son of God. That is a position of sonship gained from giving your life to Jesus. We are all God's creation, but not all His children. According to John 1:12, "*But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name.*" (NKJV) You get the right to be called a son of God, when you accept what He has done for you by repenting and asking Jesus to come and save you.

All creation is waiting on the manifestation of the sons of God. *For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God. For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of him who subjected it in hope; because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.* Romans 8: 19 – 21 (NKJV) The creation of man has been groaning since the fall of man. Because of the believers, the world has not been totally corrupted. Once the church is raptured from the earth, it will be totally wicked. God has given us a responsibility to reconcile others back to Him.

Luke 15: 19 – 31 The Prodigal Son

- When you accepted Jesus, you became a King's kid. Your position/status automatically changes, but you must renew your mind to understand the power and authority given to you.
- Before you accepted Jesus, strongholds may have developed in your mindset. Strongholds are in your soul not your spirit. You must live from your spirit, not your soul. To remove the strongholds, an individual must spend time meditating on God's Word. Everything about your mind will change when you renew it with the Word.

- ⇒ Have you identified any strongholds that are preventing you from truly walking in your authority as a son?
- ⇒ Is your spirit in one place and your mind elsewhere?
- ⇒ Do you have a revelation of your Heavenly Father?
- ⇒ Are you not able to rejoice with others because of your own issues?
- ⇒ Demons recognize the position you hold, do you?
- ⇒ Do you spend time lining your mind up with the Word?



Galatians 4: 1 – 28

- There is no difference between an heir and a slave. An heir is someone lined up to inherit something. Slaves don't have an inheritance. Heirs are children and need to be trained and taught how to be royalty.
- When we have esteem issues, it can become difficult to view ourselves as Royalty and believe God's word for elevation for your life.
- Believers must have a Kingdom mindset and not compromise truth. Believers do not bow to the world's system.
- Jesus came so we could be adopted sons. As an adopted child you have to renew your mind, so you won't think as an abused person from the previous family. The spirit of the Son is in our hearts.
- God loves everyone equally. Love is an action verb and demonstrated. God loved us enough to allow Jesus to die for us to reconcile us back to Him. We were adopted into God's family. We must spend time understanding the rules of the family we have been adopted into. Reading and studying the Word, teaches us how to live like we are in His family.

- ⇒ If you have esteem issues, do you use God's Word to correct those issues?
- ⇒ Have you been trained in spiritual royalty?
- ⇒ Do you choose to be in bondage?
- ⇒ Do you think like an adopted child?
- ⇒ What do people say about your name?
- ⇒ What does the consistency of your life look like?
