~ The Wound Affect ~ Prophetess Felecia Carter Wade

As life happens, you must stand firm and declare the freedom in which Christ has given you. The enemy wants you bound in some way shape, form, or fashion. God wants us free. He wants us free in every area of our life. When you operate out of your wounded soul, you make decisions out of that wounded place. Because of the hits you have taken during your life, you may be bound and not realize it. Being bound can cause us to develop a personality that's not actually who we are but is a deep wound that hasn't healed. God is so full of grace, mercy, and love for His people. He wants us whole, delivered, and healed. Healing allows you to be the person God created you to be.

Definitions

- ⇒ Hurt: The emotional damage of an inflicted wound, to inflict with physical pain, a substantial wound, to damage, to cause emotional pain or anguish intended to be detrimental, to hamper or suffer pain or grief, to be in need, or discomfort caused by illness or injury.
- ⇒ Pain: The feeling that derives from a wound.
- ⇒ Wound: A rapid onset of injury that involves lacerated or punctured skin, an open wound or contusion, or closed wound from blunt force trauma.

According to the level of contamination the wound can be classified as clean (made in sterile condition and the skin is likely to heal without complications) or contaminated (caused from an accidental injury resulting in signs of infection).

Degrees of Wounds Experienced by People

- ⇒ Infected: Wounds that haven't been tended to which causes oozing from the wound affecting others that you come into contact with.
 - o Examples of an infected wound:
 - A person with a not so pleasant attitude.
 - A person who consistently verbalizes critical criticism.
- ⇒ Open: Wounds caused by a clean sharp object.

- o Example of an open wound:
 - A person who has been wounded by words that cut them deeply in their soul.
- ⇒ Gunshot: Gunshots are generally wounds encountered in close proximity (someone near in distance to you).
 - o Example of a gunshot:
 - A person who is wounded by someone close to you. The person you would least expect to hurt you.

As believers, we should not stay in the place of our wound. If our heart stays in that place too long, we will live out of our wound. God doesn't want us to live out of our wounds. Any wounds not tended to, will breed more serious conditions, and derail us from our purpose. A wound can be accidently or on purpose, but it still causes pain. The effects of the wound will show up right at the point God is ready to elevate you.

Exodus 2: 1 - 12

- Wounds have the potential to keep believers from fulfilling the call of God in their life. When you cry out to God, He hears your prayers.
 - o Have you spoken to God concerning your wounds?
 - o What scripture(s) has (have) He given you to aid in your healing?
- 2. Divine purpose shields you from the enemy. Moses had two different cultures inside of him. Moses was born a Hebrew and called to be a deliverer. He was raised by Pharaoh's daughter, but his mother nursed him. He experienced palace life but he knew the Hebrew culture. Moses was burdened by the treatment of the Hebrews. The burden resulted in him killing an Egyptian out of rage. The beginning of Moses healing process was his encounter with God (burning bush).
- o What is your divine purpose?

- o Do you have two cultures within you (Lukewarm)?
- o Has the enemy tried to use your burdens/wounds to make you into something that is not in the will of God for you?
- o Have you spoken to God concerning what burdens your heart?
- o What was your burning bush?

1 Samuel 18: 1 – 15

David avenged God and it changed the trajectory of his life. Saul took David into his home. While in Saul's household, David acted wisely. David was appointed to the position. He didn't ask for it. David's heart was pure, and God put him in the forefront. God (the anointing) was on David, and it was visible to Saul. Saul was intimidated by the anointing and tried to kill David.

- o Are you waiting on God to elevate you, or do you try to elevate yourself?
- o Are you honorable concerning your leadership?
- o If you have experienced a leadership wound, have you spoken to God about it?
- o Have you checked your heart to ensure you don't harbor any ill will feelings towards others?

2 Samuel 13

Father wounds are not who you are, but what you have experienced. Father wounds (natural or spiritual) must be healed in order to receive your full identity in Christ (Who you are and who you're supposed to be.) Father wounds have the capacity to cut deep, because there is a level of expectancy from you. Either the father didn't have what you needed, chose not to give it to you, abandoned/rejected you, cut you with his words, or touched you in a manner not of a father.

Absalom had father issues that breeded betrayal. Absalom was King David's third son. Amnon, (half-brother) was the first and favorite son as well as next in line to be king. Amnon had a spirit of perversion and raped Tamar (half-sister). After his lust was fulfilled, he had her thrown out. Absalom directed Tamar not to speak of it or take it to heart. After hearing about the rape King David became angry, but he didn't punish Amnon. Absalom become wounded because of Tamar's wounds and murdered entered his heart.

- ⇒ Wounds have the capability to travel through generations. Have you recognized any family wounds? What have you done about it?
- ⇒ Have you ever had to deal with sibling rivalry or experienced the "favorite child" issue?
- ⇒ What has entered into your heart because of inflicted wounds?

Erase Wounds From Your Bloodline:

- 1. Acknowledge the wound.
- 2. Forgive those who inflicted the wound.
- 3. Repent on your behalf and your forefathers.
- 4. Repent of the cycle (generational).
- 5. Renew your mind and not repeat it.

Prayer

Let your blood speak of better promises for my bloodline. Thank you for nailing all of our iniquities to the cross, in the name of Jesus. Holy Father, remove our case out of the throne room of judgment into the throne room of grace and mercy. Let grace and mercy be our portion. Let grace and mercy be my children's portion. Let grace and mercy flow throughout my bloodline, in the name of Jesus. Thank you, father, for making me whole. Thank you for healing me now. Go in Holy One and close every wound. Go in with your Holy needle and your Holy thread and sew the wound up right now that it will no longer breed pus and infection, in the name of Jesus. Go through Holy One and wash it. I forgive.
