

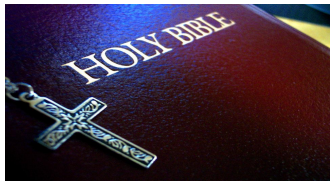

Heaven or Hell Series Finale Apostle Tony Wade

Believers shouldn't be stumbling blocks for others. Because there are more scriptures written about hell than heaven, it is a very important topic. Hell is a real eternal destination for those who choose to reject Jesus' blood sacrifice. As believers who share the gospel, we must be cognizant of what we are preaching/ministering/saying to others about the gospel. We must take heed to what we say. We will give an account of our "message". Your message is God's word tested and tried through your life. As a believer, your lifestyle must reflect Christ and not propagate a false doctrine.



God's Word will not return void!

Hebrews 9: 27

- ⇒ Grace and mercy are for the living. Grace is an unmerited favor (getting what you didn't earn). Mercy is not getting what you earned.
- ⇒ Once an individual dies in the state of being away from God, there is no more grace and mercy.
- ⇒ We die one time, then there is judgment.
- ⇒ Judgment is the consequence of the decision made while on earth.

John 3: 16 – 18, 36

- ⇒ Hell is a choice. People are not going to accidentally go to hell.
- ⇒ We are all predestined to be saved, but that doesn't mean all of us will be saved. Some people choose hell. Why? They want God's benefits, but not God.

- ⇒ "God gave His only begotten son" to die for whosoever. All of us have the same opportunity to choose God.
 - How are you intentional about witnessing to "whosoever" about his/her eternal destination?
 - ⇒ We have free will (The right to choose.). We can choose to follow the Lord, or we can choose not to follow the Lord. If you choose unwisely, it could cost you your eternal destiny.
 - ⇒ God didn't send Jesus into the world to find us guilty because we were already guilty. Jesus came to free us from the law of sin and death.
 - ⇒ Either a person is operating under the Law of Sin and Death or under the Law of Life in Christ.
 - Can a person live under the Law of Life in Christ, but experience the Law of Sin and Death operating in their life?
 - ⇒ Judgment belongs to God in the case of unbelievers, but the body of Christ is required to be fruit inspectors.
 - Because loving and serving are what we do, how have you loved someone up when the fruit was "rotten".
 - Give an example of when someone had to "love you up".
 - ⇒ Darkness has a problem with light because the light shines a spot-on evil.
 - ⇒ Everyone who practices sin, is operating under the Law of Sin and Death.
 - Are you practicing evil? {gossip, lying, cursing, sexual sins, sins of the heart}
 - ⇒ He that believes in the Son has everlasting life. Belief is trust.
 - Do you have total trust in the Son?
 - In what area(s) of your life, are you wavering in your trust?
- 1 John 2: 1 – 5
- ⇒ The doctrine of once saved always saved is not accurate. A believer is saved as long as he/she stays in right standing with God.
 - ⇒ God will never leave you nor forsake you, but you are able to walk away from Him.
 - How is your personal walk with God?
 - What keeps you from walking away from God?

- o If you have ever “walked away” from God, what caused you to return to Him?
- ⇒ Jesus is our advocate (attorney). If a believer misses the mark (sins), he/she is able to go to Jesus and ask Him for forgiveness and allow His blood to cleanse him/her. Jesus paid the price for sin by his blood.
- ⇒ Believers are recognizable because they keep God’s commandments and God’s love is matured in them.
 - o Are you keeping the commandments that are most comfortable to our lifestyle?
 - o Do you allow Holy Spirit to mature you?
- ⇒ When we abide in Jesus, we are perfected. We are saved and we are being saved. We do not practice sin.
- ⇒ If you are practicing sin, you are negating Holy Spirit’s voice.
- ⇒ We are to lead Holy Spirit led lives.
 - o Do you allow Holy Spirit to lead you in every area of your life?
- Matthew 25: 31 – 33, 41 & Isaiah 5: 14**
- ⇒ God is going to separate the sheep from the goats.
- ⇒ Hell was created for the devil and his angels.
- ⇒ Hell enlarges itself every day.

Proverbs 27:20
- ⇒ Hell and destruction are never full; so, the eyes of man are never satisfied. Flesh will never be satisfied.
 - o What strategies do you use to keep your flesh under?

Revelation 14: 9 – 11
- ⇒ The mark of the beast will be required to buy or sell goods. There is no repentance after you receive the mark of the beast. Your mind must be made up to not receive the mark.
 - o Are you developing your relationship with God to trust in Him regardless of what is going on in the earth?
- ⇒ There is no rest, peace, strength, or sleep in hell. Hell is a place of torment forever.

Isaiah 14: 9
- Luke 16: 19 – 31**
- ⇒ A believer must have the reverential fear of the Lord.
- ⇒ There is no cross over. Eternal destinations are chosen before an individual leaves the earth.
