

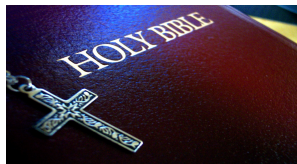

~ Heaven or Hell ~ Apostle Wade

Eternal locations are based on righteousness or unrighteousness. People don't go to heaven because they are good, nor do people go to hell because they are bad. A person can be righteous with Christ or unrighteous without Christ. God's righteousness is not based on good or bad, but on the finished work of Jesus Christ. Receiving the message of Jesus Christ (gospel) makes us righteous. Salvation is personal. Salvation comes from believing in your heart and confessing with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and Savior. God's righteousness is the standard we must live by.



GOD'S WORD WILL NOT RETURN VOID.

Romans 10: 1 – 15

- ⇒ Zeal is being totally sold out and committed to something, someone, or a cause. Paul wanted believers to have a zeal for God according to knowledge. When an individual is ignorant (unlearned) of God's righteousness, he/she will establish his/her own righteousness.
- Have you ever had a zeal for something, then realized it was in error?
 - Is your lifestyle based on God's righteousness or your interpretation of God's righteousness?
 - Before committing to something, do you seek God's knowledge of it?
- ⇒ Verse #8 – 10: *“But what does it say? “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, the word of faith which we preach):⁹ that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead,*

you will be saved.¹⁰ For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”

- ⇒ Salvation is personal. A person believes with his/her heart and confesses with his/heart mouth.
- Are your heart and mouth aligned concerning your salvation?
 - Does your alignment (heart, mouth, and God's word) influence someone to desire Jesus?
- ⇒ As believers, we should not be ashamed of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Our life should be an epistle for non-believers to read. Our life “should preach” inspire others to walk in truth. Some people say, “I don't speak about politics or religion.” It is our responsibility to speak about the Gospel even if it comes with persecution.
- If someone read your “epistle”, would it direct them to Jesus?
 - How do you stand for truth in your metron?
 - Are you built to stand for truth even in the face of persecution?
- ⇒ Repentance means to change direction. When we accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior of our life (repented), our life is no longer our life. It belongs to Christ. We are immediately seated with Christ in heavenly places, but we must grow. Developing a relationship with God is a journey (process). Your relationship with God is developed through the word.
- Do you have areas in your life that haven't changed since accepting Christ?
 - Are you living your life through flesh or truth?
 - Think of an area in your life that needs development (growth). What scriptures are you meditating for growth?
 - What prohibits you from putting your total trust in God?

- If you have placed total trust in God, how does your walk encourage others to do the same?

⇒ Each day, we should be closer to God (relationship) than the day before. As believers, we can't become high minded and forget the power of the blood. Scripture says, "Whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved." "While we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." "If any man be in Christ, he is a new creature." When we veer from truth, Holy Spirit's conviction realigns us.

- Are you intentional about developing your relationship with Holy Spirit?
- Do you recognize the delivering power of the blood?
- Does Holy Spirit's conviction lead you to repentance and realignment?

John 14: 1 – 11

⇒ Jesus came through the Jewish lineage and died for us all. You must come through the shed blood of Jesus because He is the only way to heaven. Jesus is our mediator. He speaks to the Father on our behalf. When you miss the mark, it is Jesus's blood that speaks on your behalf.

⇒ There is ONE God manifested in three persons: Father, Son (Jesus), and Holy Spirit. God and Jesus are in heaven. Heaven is heaven because that is where God lives. Holy Spirit is on the earth helping believers.
