The One Jesus Loved

- *One of them, the disciple whom Jesus loved ... John 13:23 NIV*
- *... the disciple whom [Jesus] loved ... John 19:26 NIV*
- *... the other disciple, the one Jesus loved ... John 20:2 NIV*
- *Then the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter ... John 21:7 NIV*
- *Peter ... saw that the disciple whom Jesus loved ... John 21:20 NIV*

This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins. 1 John 4:10 NLT
