the resurrection of the body,

***Hades:* temporary holding place for souls awaiting judgment**

***Gehenna:* the place of eternal separation from God in hell**

... [Jesus] never sinned, but he died for sinners to bring you safely home to God. He suffered physical death, but he was raised to life in the Spirit. ¹⁹So he went and preached to the spirits in prison—²⁰those who disobeyed God long ago ... 1 Peter 3:18-20 NLT
