4. Conclusion

- God's love is universal: It includes every nation, tribe, race, class, and gender. He died for the rich, the poor, the free, the enslaved, the old and the young.
- God's love is gracious and merciful: His gracious love refers to the kindness of God, who loves sinners even when they were an enemy of Him. (Romans 5:8)
- God's love is sacrificial: God didn't send His son to earth as a
 role model but as a perfect and atoning sacrifice for our sin.
 Christ substituted for us once and for all (1 John 2:2).

- God's love is beneficial: Those who receive Christ will not be condemned (Romans 8:1), or be captive to sin (Romans 6:11). They are declared righteous (2 Corinthians 5:21) and given eternal life (John3:16).
