3. **Conclusion**

- Conversion is required: We must turn from sin and turn to Him
- Conversion requires a clear understanding of the gospel: I am a sinner and He is the Savior.
- Conversion requires genuine faith: a real trust in the Lord, not lip service.
- Conversion is followed by a changed life: We are turning from the old and turning to the new. Doesn't mean your perfect, but it means God is working on you.
- Conversion results from God's action: Christ died, was buried, and rose from the dead. There was nothing I could have done to save myself. Salvation is in Christ alone.
