# Dear Younger Me

Biblical Truth I Wish I Knew Earlier



November 10, 2019

Two weeks ago I enjoyed exploring Biblical wisdom about spiritual growth and maturity with you. The ultimate goal is to becoming more and more like Christ (Eph. 4:16, NLT). In addition to the grace God gives us in order to spiritually mature, there are four fundamental discipleship practices: fluency in scripture, active prayer, intentional community, and service to others. Luke includes all of these in his description of the earliest gatherings of Jesus' followers, including, "All the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had." (Acts 2:44, NLT). It seems as though everyone had enough.

If humanity's oldest existential question is, "Why am I here?" then perhaps humanity's oldest practical question is, "Is there enough to sustain me here?" Our answer to that simple question becomes the starting point for every other choice we make. There is so much evidence to suggest there is not enough, but Jesus taught there was enough — maybe even more than enough! Part of Jesus' training regimen included the radical reprogramming of his followers' thinking from a "scarcity mindset" to an "abundance mindset."

This week we'll learn some background to Jesus' revolutionary view of the created order as overflowing with resources, and then we'll join his disciples' training program with six principles meant to set us free to share what God has given us.
