Chancel Choir | Thursdays, 7pm & Sundays, 9:30am

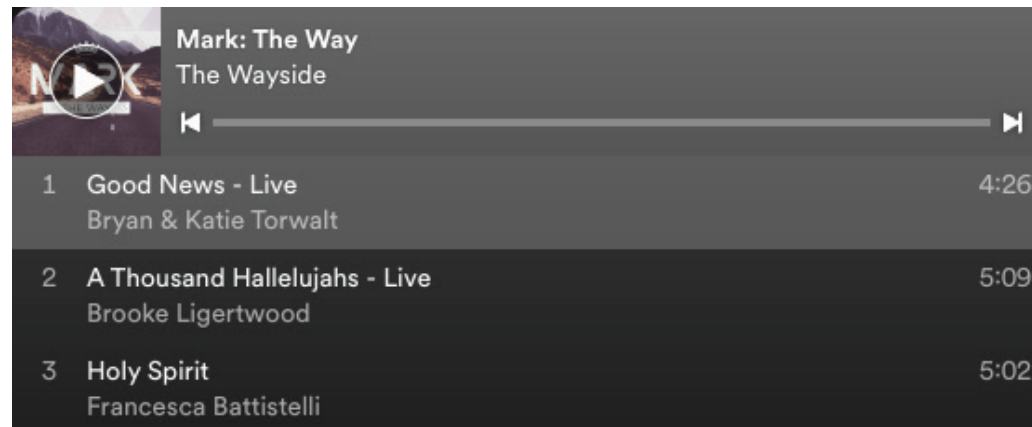

MARK REFLECT & ACT

Jesus befriended some of the most ostracized and disliked people in society and invited them to join his group of disciples.

Who do you tend to avoid or ignore? Are there certain groups of people who make you fearful or uncomfortable? How might you begin to cross boundaries and build relationships with those outside of your existing social circles?

Stereotypes often become our way of understanding people we don't know. An easy way to begin breaking stereotypes is to read, watch, or listen to content created by people who come from different backgrounds than us.

Assess the people groups represented in the content you consume. Add a book, podcast, or video series written or created by an underrepresented group.
