Women's Cancer Support Group by Sue Walen

The Women's Cancer Support Group started in 2014. As a nurse, I started attending to be of support, help with resources and to pray for the women who attended. I was asked to take on the role of facilitator of the Women's Cancer Group about six years ago.

When I find out a woman has cancer, I contact her in person or by phone, let her know about the group and invite her to attend. Since COVID, we meet once a month via zoom and have 12 to 15 women attend. They are all in different stages of cancer from actively fighting cancer to being cancer free. Each woman shares her story and lets us know her praises and prayer requests. There are questions that are answered, tips for side effects from chemo and most importantly, support! We open with a devotion and always end in prayer. Some comments from those who have attended are, "It is so supportive to know you aren't the only one going through cancer and feel the way you do." "The reason we get together isn't good, but the support is immeasurable."

It's an honor and a blessing to know the stories and to be able to pray for each participant. I listen and let the Holy Spirit lead us. It's the relationships I have been able to build with these beautiful women that humbles me. It's all the Lord's work!
