NAR REFLECT & A

The first act of Jesus' ministry was to declare that God's reign has come near, and to invite others to join him (Mk. 1:15-17). How is God inviting you into Jesus' ministry in the world? What is your response?

Prayer is the foundation for all that we do in following Jesus. Take time this week to complete this simple prayer exercise.

- Reflect upon things that get in the way of you fully saying yes to Jesus and all that he is calling you to do.
- 2. Write them down on a piece of paper and note the fears, emotions, and thoughts you have around what you wrote.
- 3. Crumple up the paper, tightly clasp it in your hand, and lament aloud to God what you are feeling.
- 4. Give yourself permission to release the things that are holding you back, tear the paper up, and let the pieces fall to the floor, releasing them to Jesus.
- 5. With your burdens released, prayerfully ask the Holy Spirit to reveal what steps God wants you to take next.

Consider joining Rooted, where you'll learn to practice 7 rhythms essential to a healthy relationship with Jesus.
