"Only God, being rich in mercy ... has made us alive together with Christ ..." Ephesians 2:4

This week we explore a facet of Moses' call and journey that is an "only God" moment. In the burning bush of our lives we hear God's voice and the calling to lead holy lives in pursuit of the Kingdom of God. And of course, that is what the church is called to collectively.

At our congregational meeting last week, I shared a few "only God" ways that he is moving in our community. When you get a chance, take a few minutes to read the annual report. You should be so proud. As a leadership, your Session has worked for years on cultivating a clear and aligned church mission and identity. But only God could take that work and manifest the beautiful transformation in our lives. Know that we are moving ahead on several key initiatives.

As the warmer weather comes, we are preparing for Phase 3 of the Opening Doors Campaign. We've all been blessed by the revitalization of our campus, and the completion of Phase 3 will focus on expanding and making our parking lot safer not only on Sunday but every day of the week. Look for updates on this project later in the summer.

Also, I'm excited to announce a dream that us coming to reality: Holy Land Pilgrimage 2020. For years now, I've been wanting to lead a Holy Land trip to Jerusalem and to take a pilgrimage tour with our members. This past Spring Pastor Harlan and I have been interviewing various ministries that would lead us in this discipleship journey. This last month we agreed to work with Telos Group to lead our church on a 10-day experience of the Holy Land. Look for information gatherings this Fall, and registrations opening in November. I'm looking forward to this experience and wanted you to know as soon as possible so that families can begin saving and reflecting on whether this is the time to go to the Holy Land.
